The Exhibition this year will take place in the Corn Exchange, Blandford Forum on the weekend of 30th and 31st May 2026 and judging will take place on 18th April 2026, when the Judge will be Huw Alban, an extremely competent and well respected judge.

The entry prices will be £10-00 for set of three per class entered. Entry price for a triptych will be as for set of three £10-00.

We shall continue using this application because it can be directly filled in on a computer in order to try and reduce errors. If you are planning entering this year please fill in the Entry Form before printing (including all honours) and use as many forms as you require. It must be stressed that submission of an entry for the Exhibition will not guarantee the image being hung, as space for entries may become slightly limited. The Judge on judging day will select any images that are not to be hung. IMPORTANT

Please carefully read the following notes as changes have been made to the acceptable picture size and copyright.

GUIDANCE NOTES

Colour Prints:

The picture may be any size and must be mounted either in a cut-out frame with mounting board behind the opening for

strength and security and the print complete with mount not exceeding 500mm x 400mm, or surface mounted on a board of similar maximum dimensions. Block mounted prints are also acceptable, but the total thickness of any entry must not exceed 4mm. No pictures mounted in frames will be allowed. No marks will be allowed on the front of the entry that may identify the entrant, and titles are required, written clearly on the reverse and/or on the front of the mount.

Monochrome Prints:

Monochrome is defined as Black and White, or a picture containing a single colour, i.e. Brown (Sepia), Blue (Cyanotype) etc. The picture may be any size and must be mounted either in a cut-out frame with mounting board behind the opening for strength and security and the print complete with mount not exceeding 500mm x 400mm, or surface mounted on a board of similar maximum dimensions. Block mounted prints are also acceptable, but the total thickness of any entry must not exceed 4mm. No pictures mounted in frames will be allowed. No marks will be allowed on the front of the entry that may identify the entrant, and titles are required, written clearly on the reverse and/or on the front of the mount.

Tryptych or Set of Three

The entry shall consist of a set of three related colour prints or

three related mono prints of the same size. All prints to be mounted in the same size and colour mount with a maximum overall size of 500mm x 400mm. If desired a triptych may be entered instead with each print the same size and a maximum overall size including mount of 1000mm x 800mm. With a maximum thickness of 4mm.

Projected Digital Images (PDIs):

Images may be either colour or monochrome. They should be up to a maximum width of 1920px and up to a maximum height of 1440px, the maximum resolution of the projector. Please note that Pixels/Inch is totally immaterial. Only jpegs are acceptable at 8 or 16 bits per channel, and each image should have a filename formatted thus:

1st Name Surname Distinctions_Title_Exhibition2026.jpg

Any valid characters may be used in the filename with the exception of the underscore character (_), of which there must be two, the first separating the photographer's name from the title, and the second separating the title from the class, which is Exhibition2026, (no space in Exhibition2026). It would be helpful, though is not vital, if the title were formatted to title case, i.e. A Walk in the Woods rather than A Walk In The Woods, A walk in the woods etc.

All PDIs may be entered by sending images to ian.ferris@bfccclub.co.uk with entry form and payment by bank transfer.

All images must have been taken using the photographic process, either digitally or on film, and all elements of the image must be the sole copyright of the photographer/entrant.
